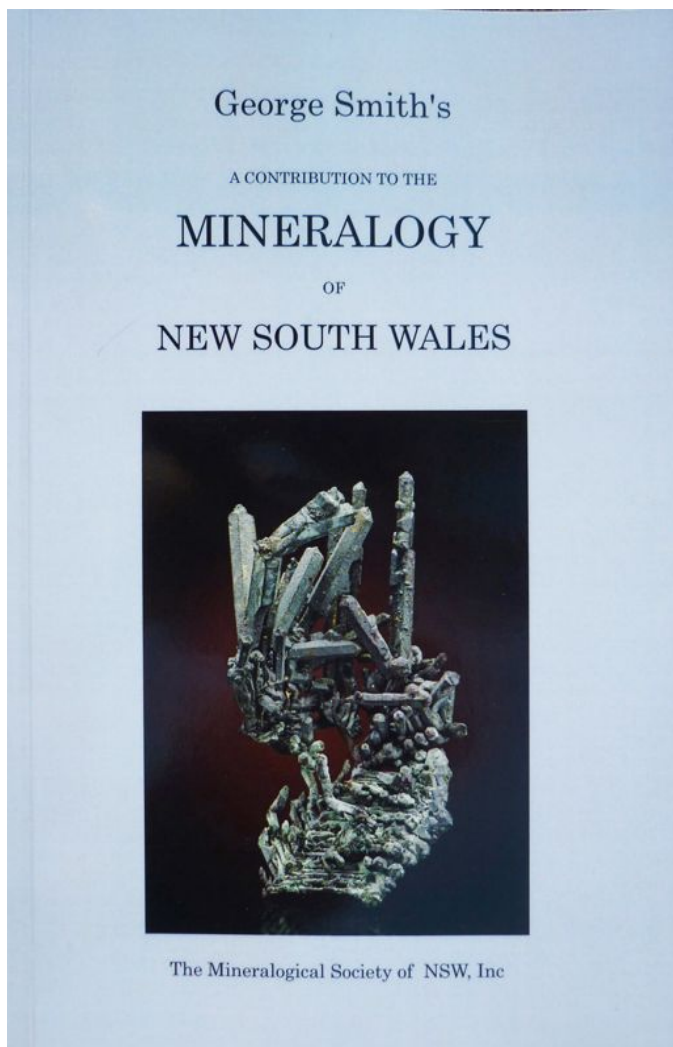

George Smith's "A Contribution to the Mineralogy of New South Wales"

An important reference for both mineralogists and mineral collectors.

The book was largely based on first-hand observations and knowledge the author gained while serving as Inspector of Mines in NSW and Manager of the Consols Mine at Broken Hill.

As the original publication has long been out of print, and is now difficult to obtain, it has been reproduced by the Mineralogical Society of NSW as a faithful reproduction including the original text, plates, diagrams, fold-out map and index. In addition there are new colour photographs of almost 60 George Smith specimens, along with a short biography of his life.

The book is reproduced in the original format, has 187 pages plus plates, and a soft cover. There is a limited print run of 200 copies.
