INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE APRIL AGAMEXPO

Peter Beckwith of AGAMExpos has extended a formal invitation to the Society to attend and display Society information and selections of member's mineral specimens at the forthcoming National Gem & Crystal Expo to be held at the Hawkesbury Indoor Stadium over the weekend of the 9th & 10th of April.

One or one and a half tables can be provided to set up and display Society information including a display of specimens, possibly including a microscope to show the public what the Society is and what we do. Volunteers to 'man' such an informational stall are invited to offer their help.

In addition a number of display cases of various sizes can be provided for members to display a selection of their collections. Cases supplied could be either upright 2000mm x 450mm x 900mm or flat cases of about 900mm x 500mm x 300mm high. The collection display cases would be set up in a designated display area that will be patrolled by a security guard. The only real condition would be that displays would need to be set up on the Friday and collected after 4pm on the Sunday afternoon. There will be **no cost** to the Society for the space given to them.

The Hawkesbury Indoor Stadium is a very large venue and the AGAMExpo held last year was very well attended by the general public. Displays of member's minerals are likely to be well appreciated by the visitors. There are already some Society members who have indicated that they can provide a display of specimens and anyone else is invited to offer to participate. For more information or offers to attend the Expo as an exhibitor, members should inform the Society Vice-President, John Chapman, or the Secretary, George Laking, who will be organising the Society contribution.
